Creating a data register on primary producers

Context

A tool that centralizes key information on producers can be of great use to advisors. Such a primary producer register should collect the following data:

- names
- certificate numbers
- crops and species grown / raised.

The aim of such a register is to provide advisors with a summary of the information available on the farmer. It facilitates the work of the advisor, but can also meet the expectations of consumers by providing information on the products origin, production methods, traceability, etc.

The positive points of these tools are the centralization and the facilitation of the access to information, for the advisor as well as for the producer who sees his documents and information centralized in a single platform or tool.

Recommendations

- It is important to keep in mind that the personal information of producers must not be made public
- The register must comply with European legislation in terms of General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).
