Context

The advisory service is keeping up with the flow of digital transformation and striving to be more innovative, more responsive and accessible to farmers at all times.

Innovative solution

The use of a common platform for knowledge transfer and easy communication (via text or video) allows farm advisors to provide faster and better services to farmers with professional content from all areas of agriculture in one place.

The E-learning is based on the Moodle platform and thus designed and adapted to the needs of farmers. The professional content of the platform is supported by advisors, including specialists in different areas of agriculture.

Recommendations

- E-learning platform has to contain video trainings, forums, workshops, an overview of all trainings
- It could also have a section of events and important dates in agriculture, the possibility of obtaining certificates from trainings, etc.
