## Context

Advice and knowledge transfer to dairy farms has focused on improving genetics and nutrition. However, less emphasis has been placed on the management of animal health on dairy farms. The consequences are high levels of lameness and hoof disease in dairy cows, frequent udder, uterine and other inflammations. These facts undoubtedly reduce competitiveness and milk production in Southeast Europe.

## Innovative solution

Digital health and welfare monitoring could enable effective and more efficient analysis of herd health problems, and successful disease prevention. Dairy farmers advisors need competencies and tools to be able to advise their clients on the opportunities and risks of investing in new technologies such as robotization and digitalization of a specific dairy farm.

DATs could help advisors share knowledge on this topic and better inform farmers.
