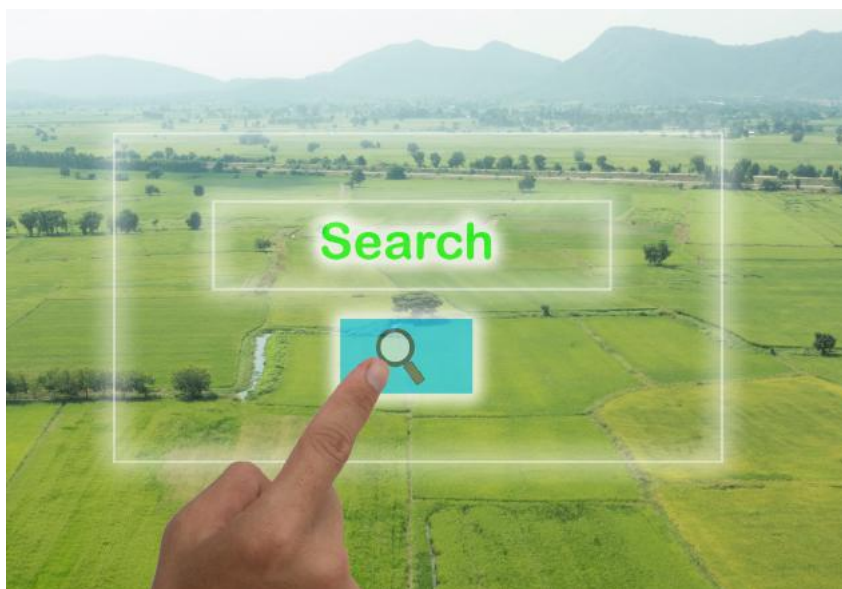

Context
